03:05am Assault – 1750 North Roberts Road, Cowboys

A security officer told a 21 year old Dallas man to leave the club because they were closing. The man mouthed off at the security officer so the officer took his arm and guided him to the door. The man then tackled the security officer and in doing so hit his head on a table. When an officer arrived the injured offender shouted profanities at him. The man was arrested and put in the back of the patrol car at which time he began banging his head against the plastic divider. He was charged with battery and disorderly conduct.

03:20AM Assault – 2500 Cobb Parkway

A citizen reported that a man was being assaulted by another male in the parking lot. An officer spoke to two people who said the offender pulled the victim out of his car and punched him in the face twice before running away. Shortly after, a car was seen leaving the parking lot of Dairy Queen parking lot. The 21 year old victim was treated for injuries at the scene. He could not provide any information as to who the offender or what the motive for the assault was.

11:00am Theft – Pine Drive

A resident reported that her dogs began to bark last night at about 11:30pm. She then heard noises in her carport and found that someone had stolen her 26" 10 speed bicycle.

02:10pm Illegal Drugs – Old 41 Highway

Someone reported seeing the occupants of a 2006 Toyota truck smoking illegal drugs as it went through the drive-through of McDonalds. The truck was stopped and the three occupants were identified. A search of the truck revealed a small baggie in a tote bag that contained three pieces of methamphetamine and six tablets of Lamotrigine. All three occupants were arrested and charged with possession of methamphetamine and possession of a dangerous drug.

A resident reported that someone went into her garage sometime after the 14th and stole her 21" black Diamondback mountain bike. She said they have a habit of leaving the garage door open.

06:54pm Marijuana Possession – Old 41 Highway

An officer stopped a car for a window tint violation and saw a "blunt" wrapper lying on the center console. The officer searched the car and found marijuana between the driver's seat and center console. All three occupants were arrested and charged with a misdemeanor amount of marijuana. They were 18, 19 and 20 years old and from Powder Springs and Kennesaw.
