#### **01:20am Traffic Arrest – McCollum Parkway**

A 33 year old Acworth man was arrested and charged with turning right against a red arrow, open container of alcohol and DUI of alcohol. A breath test showed that his blood/alcohol level was .19 grams.

#### **11:33am Shoplifting – 2779 Cobb Parkway, Walgreens**

The manager reported that a man tripped the security alarm when he walked out the front door with a pair of sunglasses he didn't pay for. An officer found the man, 28 years old, walking nearby. Management chose not to prosecute but the man was barred from the store.

#### **03:20pm Theft – 2641 Kennesaw Due West Road**

Owners of a recycling business reported that someone is stealing computer parts that are being dropped off after hours.

#### **07:50pm Theft – Grant Drive**

A man reported that his Glock .40 caliber pistol was stolen from his car. He said it was stolen either while he was in Smyrna or at home. There was no forced entry.

An officer patrolling the neighborhood heard screaming and laughing at the pool and went to investigate. He found several young people swimming in their underwear. One of them, a 20 year old Atlanta woman, was arrested and charged with underage possession of alcohol.
