03:00am Theft from Auto – Leyland Drive

A man looked outside and saw a white male and Hispanic male inside a neighbor's car. He went outside and yelled at the males and they ran away. The owner of the car was alerted and she reported that a pair of Versace sunglasses were missing from the car which had been unlocked.

The business reported two small holes in a window and a BB lying outside.

06:05pm Person Drunk – 1750 North Roberts Road

An officer responded to a report of a person drunk and found EMT's attending to a 70 year old Kennesaw man who was passed out next to a taxicab. The cab driver said he brought the man to Cowboys from his home but the man then told him to take him to Carrollton. They got to Highway 92 and the man demanded to be taken back to Cowboys. Once back at Cowboys the man was drifting in and out of consciousness while drinking vodka. The cab fare was \$88 and the man had no means to pay. He was transported to a hospital for treatment. The hospital later reported that the man had suffered a brain hemorrhage before arriving at the hospital. A warrant had been taken for the man charging him with theft of services and the charges stood until the matter could be investigated further.
